Get up-close with these gentle giants all year long! Our gorillas (and our guests) are staying warm **indoors**.



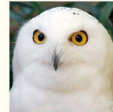
### Mouse House (B4)

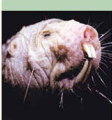

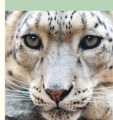
### JungleWorld (E2)
